

Monday, March 4, 2019 General Meeting Agenda 12:00pm to 1:00pm Room B7

In Attendance: Ann Marie Perozzi, Stephanie Groat, Breanne McCoy, Elizabeth Hintz

I. Call to Order

- a. Meeting called to order at 12:05pm by Ann Marie Perozzi.
- b. Welcome and introductions were made by attendees.
- c. February minutes were reviewed and a motion to approve minutes was made by Stephanie Groat. Motion was approved.

II. Event Reports - Post Events

- a. Movie Night Movie night on 2/8 was planned by Daniell Kimoto. The Incredibles 2 was shown. Pre-ordered pizza and candy packs were available. The DVD was raffled off at the end of the night. The event was well attended.
- b. Parents Night Out Movie Parents and staff met for a night out to watch *Isn't It Romantic*. As parents RSVP'd to the event they were invited to meet beforehand at Broderick's for dinner. It was a small turnout but a fun night out.
- c. Dining for Dollars California Pizza Kitchen earned \$58.76.
- d. Family Skate Night Wendi Sommers planned an 80's themed Family Skate Night at Roller King on 2/25. 139 skaters attended. Roller King charged each guest \$6 at the door. For 101-200 skaters Roller King charged Maidu PTC \$4.50. We made \$1.50 per skater for total proceeds of \$208.50. It was a fun night.
- e. Spring Picture Day Picture day went smooth and fast. Three volunteers helped and it was wrapped up by 11:30am. PTC was reminded that the Lifetouch and Shutterfly partnership allows parents to purchase merchandise through Shutterfly using the Lifetouch digital photo. Maidu PTC receives 8% of the proceeds made through the Shutterfly portal.

III. Event Reports - Current & Upcoming

- a. ESF Art Auction Jenn and Becky are on task for receiving all art projects for the event. They will be transporting art to Bayside Friday am to set up for the event. They will also be representing Maidu at the event at the Maidu booth. ESF is still looking for volunteers so please sign up via link on E-news Wednesday.
- b. Dining for Dollars The March fundraiser will be at Dos Coyotes on Douglas Blvd on Wednesday, March 13 from 5:00-9:00 p.m. The flyer was provided to Lisa.

- c. Math Night Math Night is planned for March 14. Flyers are posted around campus and went out in the eWed email. A request for volunteers to help work stations will go out in the eWed and to our PTC volunteer list.
- d. Spring Book Fair The spring book fair theme is dinosaurs. Mrs. Groat agreed to have dinosaur jokes told over the intercom for kids to enjoy.
- e. Talent Show/Ice Cream Social The talent show and ice cream social will take place on Monday, 4/8 from 5:00-7:00 to help kick-off the book fair. The book fair will be open throughout the event with the ice cream social starting at 5:30 (30 minutes) followed by the talent show beginning at approximately 6:00 (45 minutes). Jenn researched pricing for ice cream and will have families RSVP ahead of the event so she'll know how much to order. PTC will purchase ice cream and toppings from the School Activity Night budget. Mrs. Groat and Drew will meet to plan the talent show.
- f. All Family Dance Shana was not present for an update.

IV. School Report

- a. Electric Marquee Update Mrs. Groat received a quote of \$2,100 for wiring for the electronic marquee. Ann Marie made a motion to use the remaining grant budget from the Eagle Scout Project, Math Night, and Art Docent up to \$2,100 for Mrs. Groat to purchase wiring for the electric marquee. Motion approved.
- b. Mrs. Groat will order the electric marquee. It should be installed before the end of the school year.

V. Treasurer's Report

- a. 2018-19 Grants The budget presented shows grants that were approved in 2017/18 but previously omitted from the 2018/19 budget. Mrs. Groat clarified that any funds leftover after staff shirts were purchased would be used toward classroom seating.
- b. Fall book fair profits A check for \$1,000 will be made out to Maidu and deposited into the school's library fund for the librarian to purchase needed supplies.
- c. Room Parents no updated was provided.
- d. Art Docent Ann Marie will send a reminder to Helena that there is budget available if the art docent program needs any additional supplies.
- e. Garden nothing to report.
- f. Staff Appreciation Ann Marie put Valentine's with a chocolate candy in staff boxes.
- g. Box Tops/Amazon Smile/Shutterfly MacLeane's 3rd grade class won the box top competition and will receive an extra recess and bubble play. Mrs. Groat and Breanne will help during the recess. An estimated \$165 was collected in box tops. Amazon Smile made a quarterly deposit of \$10.14 to our account.
- h. Spirit Wear Spirit wear was distributed to students. Elizabeth does not recommend using this company in the future. It was recommended to consider a wider range of spirit wear products for Fall 2019 (i.e., sweatpants, coffee cups) and to use a more traditional Maidu logo.
- i. Coordinator List the list is up-to-date on the PTC website.

j. Social Media - The Maidu Elementary School Facebook page is live. Mrs. Groat will make posts. Ann Marie also has administrative rights to post PTC news and events.

VI. President's Report

- a. District News Mrs. Groat shared that ESF conducted a call-a-thon to families that have not donated \$365 to ESF. The District is seeking input for the Local Control Accountability Plan in March. Two Maidu teachers will be retiring this year and new student registration is underway.
- b. Open Discussion Sami's Circuit Family Night will be at the school on Wednesday, March 20th from 6:00-7:00.
